Job Summary

A Chainman in the Land Settlement Agency would be responsible for routine manual activities involved in land surveying. He would assist the Licensed Land Surveyor in the execution of surveys especially with the clearing of lines of sight, chaining and the holding of poles and staves. His immediate supervisor would be the head of the particular crew of which he is part.

Organizational Relationships

- Reports directly to the Land Surveyor and the Senior Land Surveyor.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Establishes survey points.
- Slopes chain and step chain.
- Cuts and clears survey lines.
- Range – in lines over varying terrain.
- Ability to use plumb-boobs, prisms poles and level staves.
- Maintains surveying equipment.
- Carries out all survey related instructions.
- Maintains workroom.
- A compulsory requirement of the position is to be part of the Multi-occupational team comprising of members of the Unit. This team is to ensure that the Unit effectively and efficiently meet its goals and satisfies its standards for discipline and productivity.

Qualifications, Training and Experience

- Possession of a Technical/ Vocational Certificate specializing in Practical and Engineering Surveying from a recognized Institute
- At least three (3) years experience in the related field.
- Proficient in the use of standard surveying equipment, such as:
 - Hammers
 - Cutlasses
 - Plumb-boobs
 - Range poles
 - Prism and Prism Poles
 - Measuring Tapes
