Key Duties and Responsibilities:

- Design of Infrastructural Works viz water reticulation, sewage collection, drainage works, road-works and ancillary structures including bridges, culverts, retaining walls etc.
- Interface with Regulatory Agencies for approval of designs.
- Assists in the preparation of Bills of Quantities and other Tender Documents.

Minimum Qualifications and Experience:

- A recognized First Degree from a recognized institution in Civil Engineering.
- Professional Qualification in Civil Engineering and Registration with the Board of Engineering Trinidad and Tobago.
- Minimum of three (3) years' graduate experience in Infrastructure Design.
