The Government and private sector are consistently providing our citizens with secure, affordable and adequate housing to enhance their overall well-being and quality of life.

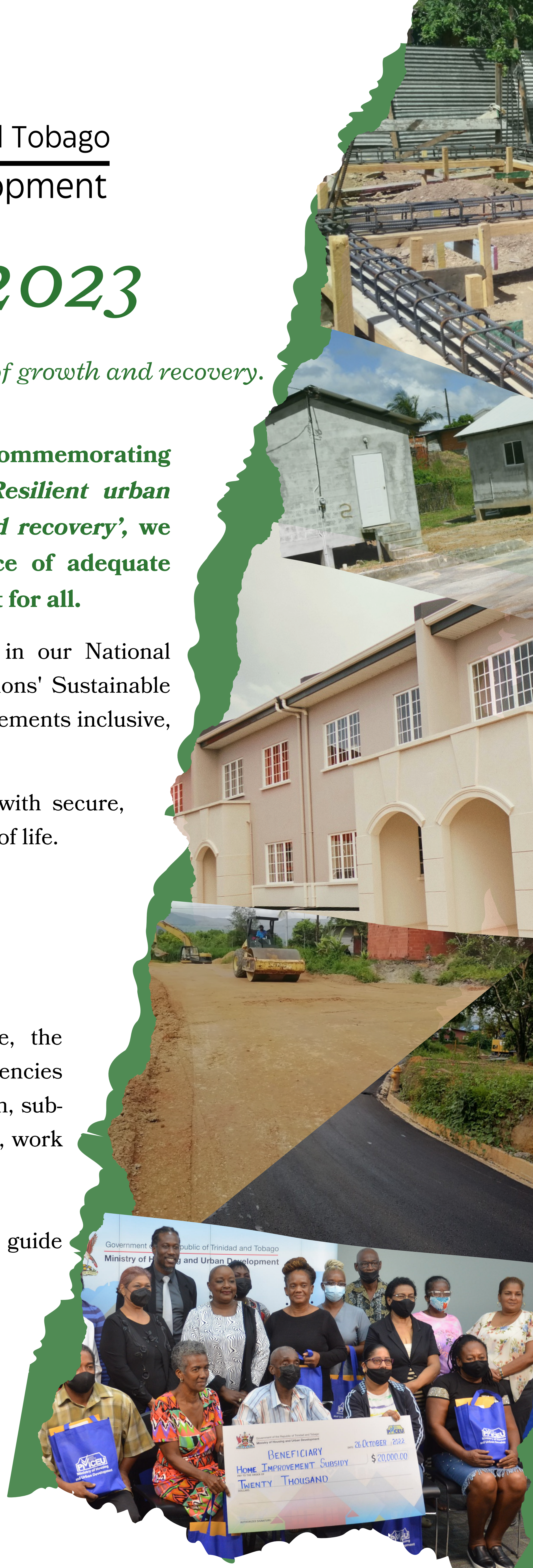
We remain dedicated to the following key areas:
